Schools Recycling Programme

Moonprint Concerts paid a visit to Doxa Deo School in the North West Province, Hartbeespoort Dam recently. The children were told how to recycle by following the few simple steps below:

- **Separate** your waste – keep dry from wet, important! Paper, especially, should be DRY
- It is possible to throw all your recyclables – **except paper** – in one container.
- Keep your **black bin** for your wet waste and non-recyclables.
- Store **four different containers** in your garage or another storage space, where the separation can then be done. Have **separate boxes or bags** for: GLASS, PAPER, PLASTIC and METALS (Including Polystyrene)
- **Store** each separate bag until it's recycling day at your school
- Take **separated recyclables** to your school on recycling day
